## Tennis Corner

Can you name the Lodge facility used nearly every week of the year by kids learning a lifelong skill, retirees staying young with a great workout and socialization, and friends, spouses, and families spending time together? Hint: this facility is available from early in the morning until lights out at 10pm.

Of course, this facility would be our four tennis courts. We are one of very few Elks Lodges privileged to have tennis courts on our property, and they are used by an active and growing tennis and pickleball playing community. There is a regular group of tennis players on Tuesday and Thursday nights who focus on playing round-robin doubles. Many of these players also play on Saturdays or Sundays. Other members use courts on Wednesday afternoon and evenings, and other members are dedicated to their Wednesday, Friday and Sunday morning games.

If you are interested in playing but are hesitant since you may not have a partner....don't be! Email [tennis@sanmateoelks.org](mailto:tennis@sanmateoelks.org) if you are interested in coming out! Court usage, policies, and projects impacting courts are overseen by Court Committee, and a member of the committee will follow-up with you to help you get started and integrated into a group. We're happy to welcome you to our courts for your enjoyment.

In addition to the Courts themselves, the Lodge has a ball machine available for use (a small annual key charge is required.) If there is sufficient member participation, the Lodge will field a team in local USTA league play. If you are interested in professional help for your game, our Lodge vendor HPI Tennis academy has certified tennis professionals who are happy to meet with you for lessons. (HPI is long-time vendor of the Lodge who conducts academy and camps on our courts at prescribed times. Feel free to say hi to one of their friendly tennis pros.)

The Courts are also used by an active pickleball group primarily on Thursdays and Sundays (pickleball courts are available any day.) Be sure to come to Court Committee Open House on September 18 at 6pm for a social hosted by the committee and you can meet your next tennis or pickleball partners. Food and drinks will be hosted by the Committee. We look forward to seeing you there, if not before, out on our courts!

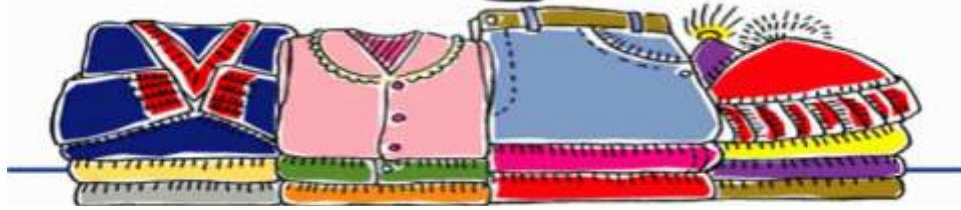
