This may be delivered under separate cover, if the writer prefers, provided it reaches our office by 5:00 pm, Friday, January 10, 2022. Please insure that the Faculty Member knows there's a deadline for this letter.
- Attach a one-page statement from one or two adult friends attesting to your qualifications for our San Mateo Elks Open Family Scholarship.
- Copies of exhibits are optional supplemental material; you may include photo copies of awards, achievement in scholarship, leadership, athletics, drama, art, and community service. Please do not include originals. We cannot accept responsibility for the safe return of original documents. Please limit to 10 pages.
- Deliver application to the Elks Lodge Office by **FRIDAY, JANUARY 10, 2022, 5PM.**
