

After that we had a fun game led by Koen called Patrol feud which is like family feud, but instead of families it's patrols. The troop had a lot of fun with this activity.







on the iron horse bike trail. While scouts were biking, a man fell off his bike and hit his head quite hard. While scouts waited for help, they tended to his injuries.
