Through the efforts of this group the Jolly Corks was renamed Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America (BPOE) in 1868. The Elk was chosen to represent this organization because it is distinctively an American animal. It lives in herds and is gentle, yet strong and courageous in defense of its own. The belief and cardinal principles of the Elks are Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love, and Fidelity. The Order of the Elks allowed women to become members in 1996.

In May we will see the opening of the pool and cantina bar for families and friends (after 11 a.m.). Enjoy the pool and your time in the sun, but remember it is your responsibility to keep your children safe.

On Mother's Day, May 12th, make the mother in your life feel special. Whether it is your mother, sister, wife, or a friend, come on down to the lodge for a great brunch, no one ever goes away hungry. 
