# News of the Elkdom



We are proud to announce that the 2022-2023 recipient of the Enrique S. Camarena Award hails from the badger state of Wisconsin. Nominated by Green Bay Lodge #259, Deputy Kyle Mason of the Brown County Sheriff's has been chosen as this year's award winner.

Plans are underway to present Deputy Mason with his award, as well as an award to the Green Bay Lodge.

Only a half point separated the top three candidates in this year's nominations. Deputy Mason is entering his 8<sup>th</sup> year of employment with the Sheriff's Office and prior to that he was a Trooper with the Wisconsin State Patrol.

For the last 6 years, Deputy Mason has been assigned to the County Drug Task Force and is also a K-9 handler. During this time he has seized over 4,700 grams of Crack; 125 grams of heroin; 14,500 grams of marijuana; 6,900 grams of meth and nearly \$571,000 in US currency.

Much of what he has done over the years could easily be characterized as "above and beyond" and he is a recipient of the Brown County Sheriff's Office Merit Award.
