South San Francisco Lodge, our sister Lodge, had a fire early last year. They have just reopened their bar and meeting areas for their members. Their gym and other areas will not open for another year or more. We have allowed usage of our Lodge during this difficult time. However, as of April 1, all courtesy access cards will be turned off for all SSF members. Any SSF member that wants to continue using our Lodge facility for exercise etc. will be allowed to purchase a Facility Use Pass (FUP) for \$250 per year. These passes are not pro-rated and will expire upon the opening of SSF completed facility. We ask all SSF members to return their key cards if not continuing after April 1. Those who do not will be charged a \$10 card fee.



“When is our boiler going to be installed for the Steam & Sauna?”

We know everyone is asking and we are expecting it to be completed by the end of January or sooner hopefully. We have the boiler; however, in the removal and preparation of the new boiler we found additional items that need to be addressed before the new boiler can be installed. We will be debuting a “Kids Cantina” offering kids drinks that will be separate from the main Cantina Bar. This will allow thirsts to be quenched as quickly as possible for everyone!

Children under 21 will NO LONGER be allowed at the Cantina Bar to purchase non-Alcoholic beverages such as Virgin Pina Coladas, Roy Rogers, etc. These will only be available at the “Kids Cantina”. The “Kids Cantina” will be offering food, ice cream, beverages, and much, much more. Further details will be announced in a later bulletin.

You may mail in your payment, drop in the office door, call in a payment to us with a credit card (650/345-4886), or provide your credit card info on the statement. You may also pay online using REVO (as noted on the statement) but you will incur a service fee if you decide to pay that way.

New membership cards will be mailed out upon receipt of your dues. If we have to turn off your access card, a \$20 service fee will be collected to restore access.
